**“Crime Prevention in Motion Initiative”**

Tampa Police Department starting networking with the Tampa Jaycees in 2008. Mr. Andrew Moos, Public Seating Coordinator and CPP Hunsberger met reference creating a initiative that would allow the Tampa Police Department to partner with the Florida Jaycees creating crime prevention messages on bus benches though out our District One. This project allows District One to send a strong proactive crime prevention message.

There are fifteen benches located in District One that target three different crime prevention initiatives: Neighborhood Watch, shoplifting and unlocked vehicles/open garage doors. After much planning, networking and dedication the Florida Jaycees created the artwork and the benches were created. Samples of the three initiatives and their locations are attached. The benches will remain in District One for one year. This initiative is called crime prevention in motion because it may be necessary to move the bench location if there is a client who would like to purchase a bench at our location. This will allow our proactive crime prevention message to reach additional communities and locations.

The shoplifting benches have been completed and installed and will remain in effect for two years. The in-kind expenses/costs are:

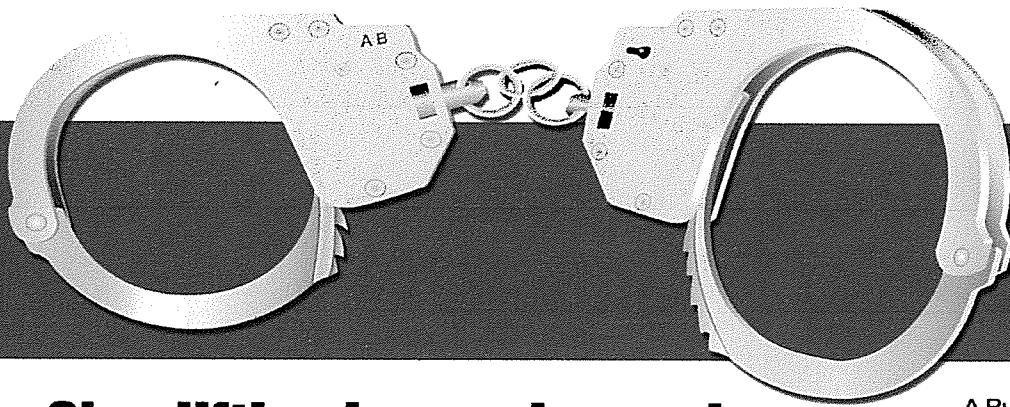
